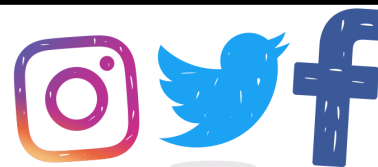

The Milford Bank and Colony Grill present the 4th Annual Milford Moves 5K on Father's Day 2018!

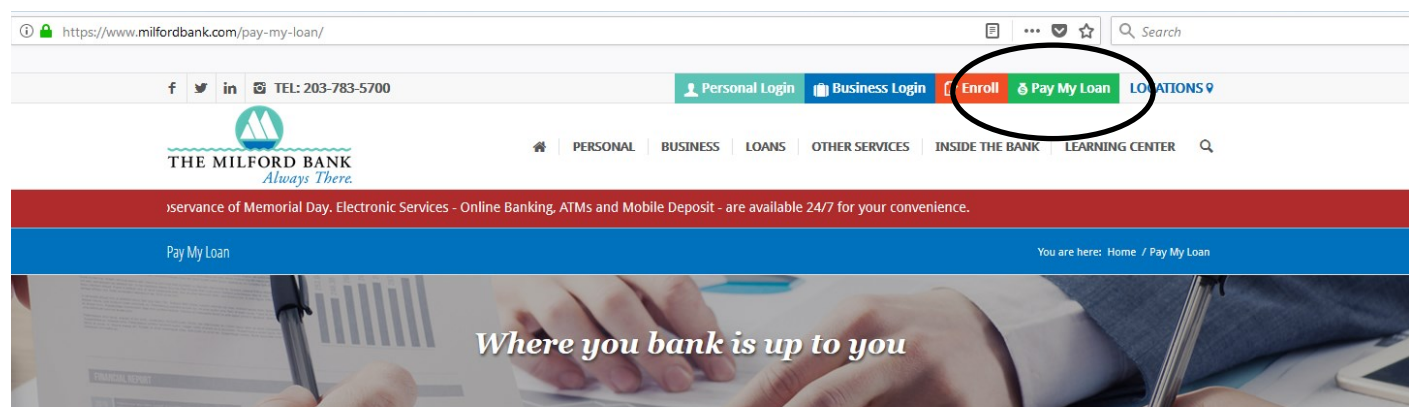

Introducing Pay My Loan!



Pay My Loan is an easy way to make your loan payment online, at no extra charge. You deserve a simple way to pay your loans that won't cost you extra. A good bank gets that.

Now you can enjoy the convenience of paying your mortgage, home equity or personal loan online. Please note that payments made after 7 pm Monday-Friday Eastern Standard Time and on weekends and holidays will be processed the next business day.

To get started, click the Pay My Loan Tab at the top of our Homepage. Register to access a secure login page. Pay your Milford Bank Loan using an account with another bank.

If you do not wish to register, you may still pay your loan online with limited functionality. Make your one time payment or view your payment history for the past 72 hours. Please note that there is a convenience fee associated with this option.
