Money-Saving Driving Techniques



Everyone benefits from efficient driving. Not only does it benefit the environment, but you'll likely spend less on gas and add to the life of your vehicle. Here are some money saving driving techniques:

Drive the speed limit: Driving at or below the speed limit can make a huge difference! The EPA estimates that driving 55 mph instead of 65 mph will save you 10-15% in fuel.

Relaxed Driving: Aggressive driving burns unnecessary fuel, so it pays to have a more laid-back driving style. Simply accelerating and braking slowly can increase fuel economy by 37%. Also avoid tailgating and weaving in traffic, as it causes unnecessary speed changes. Save an additional 14% fuel economy just by using cruise control (except for in hilly areas).

Don't Idle: Turn off your engine when stopped for more than a minute and you'll see a fuel savings of 19%.

Hypermiling: Survey road conditions and anticipate traffic conditions to avoid using the gas and brake pedals as much as possible. Use a fuel consumption display device to get instant feedback on driving by showing real-time MPG readings. These devices can be installed in most cars.

Lighten up: Decrease the weight load of the vehicle by not overloading the trunk or other storage areas. Also try to consolidate trips by grouping errands to save on gas used.
